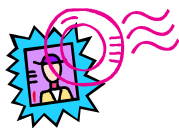

### Scriptural Rosary

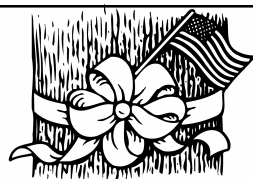
