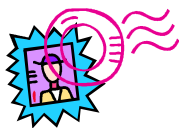

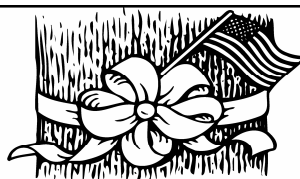


### Scriptural Rosary
