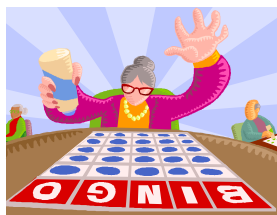

### Prayer for Vocations

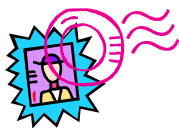
