Lenten Regulations: Fasting & Abstinence for all Catholics on **Ash Wed. and Good Friday.** All Catholics are bound by law to abstain on **ALL Fridays** of Lent whose completed 14 years of age. Catholics are obliged to fast, (one full meal and two lighter meals with no snacks between) from 18 years of age to their 60th year.
