## Religious Education

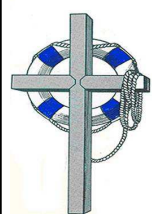
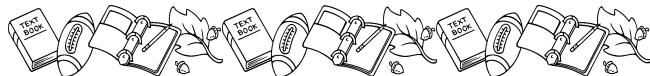

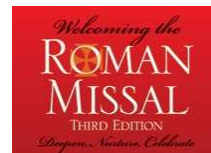
